At the start of all of our Foundation courses handlers are briefed that we need to encourage the dogs to want to retrieve and at this stage I don't care if the dog learns to carry dummies or fluffy slippers. Sarah and Jessie passed their Bronze Assessment retrieving Pink Fluffy Slippers and have now progressed to proper dummies. Demonstrating pure genius Darren gave us a real blinder by giving us all an excellent demo and assessment by encouraging his awesome English

Pointer Hubble to retrieve packets of crisps, without trying to eat them. Darren had been struggling to develop Hubble's interest in retrieving and the crisps have done their trick.

Saturday 26th October will see the start of our new Kennel Club Working Gundog Certificate Course. These sessions will encourage handlers to further develop their dogs in preparation for the Shooting field.
